Statement from PT. EastIndo Services Regarding Helicopter BK117-D3 accident

PT. EastIndo Services confirms the conclusion of the search for the helicopter (BK117-D3) that crashed on Monday, 1 September, in South Kalimantan. The wreckage was located by the National Search and Rescue Agency (BASARNAS) in Mentewe district, in Tanah Bumbu Regency, South Kalimantan, on September 3, 2025.

The helicopter departed Gusti Sjamsir Alam Airport (WAOK) at 08:45 WITA on September 1, 2025, and lost radio contact at 08:54 WITA. Following standard protocol, Eastindo immediately notified all relevant authorities and provided full operational support for the ensuing search and rescue operation.

Our hearts and deepest condolences go out to the families and loved ones of the eight person who were on board - the pilot, a crew member, and six passengers. We are directly liaising with the families, all of whom are in Banjarmasin, South Kalimantan as of today, to offer our full support during this incredibly difficult time.

PT. EastIndo Services is fully committed to cooperating with the local and national authorities as they conduct a thorough investigation to determine the cause of this accident.

Jeff Yeo, President Director, PT. EastIndo Services, stated: "We are devastated by this tragic accident. Our thoughts remain with the crew, passengers, and their families. We also extend our most sincere gratitude to BASARNAS and all other local and national authorities, including the Indonesian National Armed Forces, the Indonesian National Police, and the dedicated local communities who worked tirelessly in extremely challenging conditions to locate the helicopter and the missing persons."
